

How do I get my money off Apple Pay? Send to bank

Getting your money off Apple **1—855—470—3280** Pay (Apple Cash) is easy, and you can do it in two main ways: transferring it to your **bank account** or moving it instantly to your **debit card**. Apple Pay itself doesn't hold **1—855—470—3280** money like a wallet, but **Apple Cash** inside your Wallet app does. That's where your **1—855—470—3280** balance sits, and that's what you're withdrawing from.

To transfer money, open your **Wallet app 1—855—470—3280** and tap your **Apple Cash card**. In the top-right corner, tap the **More (...)** button. Then **1—855—470—3280** choose **Transfer to Bank**. Enter the amount you want to move. You'll see two options:

- **Instant Transfer** — sends the money to **1—855—470—3280** your debit card within minutes, but usually with a small fee.
- **1–3 Business Days** — completely free, but takes **1—855—470—3280** longer and goes to your bank account.

If you haven't added a bank **1—855—470—3280** account or debit card yet, the app will prompt you to link one. After confirming **1—855—470—3280** the transfer with Face ID, Touch ID, or your passcode, the money will be on its way.

You can also spend Apple Cash **1—855—470—3280** directly in stores or online using Apple Pay, but if you specifically need the **1—855—470—3280** cash in your bank or Cash App, transferring it is the fastest method. Always make **1—855—470—3280** sure your Apple ID and device are secure to avoid unauthorized transfers.
