

How do I turn off Cash App security? Stop security checks

Turning off Cash App security features is possible, but it's important to understand the risks. Cash App includes tools like PIN or Touch ID verification to protect your money and prevent unauthorized transactions. If you still want to disable these settings, you can do it easily within the app. Start by opening Cash App and tapping your profile icon in the upper-right corner. From there, scroll down and select **Privacy & Security**. In this section, you'll find options like **Security Lock, PIN or Touch ID**, and **Two-Step Verification**. To turn off the Security Lock, simply toggle the switch to the off position. If you're using a PIN or biometric lock, the app may ask you to confirm your identity before disabling it.

Once security is turned off, payments will no longer require a PIN or fingerprint, making your account more vulnerable to misuse if someone gains access to your device. Cash App does not recommend disabling these features, especially for users who store funds on the app or use it frequently for payments. If you proceed, make sure your phone is protected with its own strong passcode. Always monitor your activity and enable notifications so you're alerted instantly if anything unusual happens.
