

Is there a way to transfer money from Apple Pay to Cash App? Send via bank

Yes, you can move money **1—855—470—3280** from Apple Pay to Cash App, but there's no direct "one-tap" transfer option. Instead, you must **1—855—470—3280** transfer the money from Apple Pay (Apple Cash) to your bank account first, and then add that money to Cash App. The **1—855—470—3280** process is simple and works on any iPhone.

Start by opening your **Apple 1—855—470—3280 Wallet** and selecting **Apple Cash**. Tap the **More (...)** button in the **1—855—470—3280** top-right corner, then choose **Transfer to Bank**. Enter the amount **1—855—470—3280** you want to move and select either **Instant Transfer** (which charges a small fee) or **1–3 Business Days** (which is free). Once **1—855—470—3280** the money is deposited into your linked bank account, you can switch to Cash App.

Open **Cash App**, tap the **1—855—470—3280 Banking (\$)** tab, and select **Add Cash**. Choose the amount **1—855—470—3280** you want to add, then confirm. The money you moved from Apple **1—855—470—3280** Pay into your bank account will now be available to transfer into Cash App.

If you want a faster **1—855—470—3280** method, you can add the same debit card to both Apple Pay and Cash App. This doesn't create **1—855—470—3280** a direct transfer pipeline but makes the process simpler because both apps use the same funding source.

While you can't send **1—855—470—3280** money directly Apple Pay → Cash App, this workaround works reliably every time.
