Subject: REVISED FUNDING SOURCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE HYBRID PICK-UP TRUCK

At the April 17, 2018 City Council meeting, the Paramount City Council awarded the contract for the purchase of one hybrid pick-up truck to Penske Chevrolet of Cerritos in the amount of \$35,895.20. The funding source for the purchase of the hybrid pick-up truck was included in the Fiscal Year 2018 budget under the AB 2766 Subvention (or AQMD) Fund. However, after re-evaluating other funding sources for the purchase of the hybrid pick-up truck, we are recommending the use of the Equipment Replacement Fund as the funding source for the purchase of the vehicle.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended that the City Council approve revising the funding source for the purchase of one hybrid pick-up truck from the AB 2766 Subvention Fund to the Equipment Replacement Fund.
