# Councilmember Vacancy

 Councilmember Martinez: Retirement effective June 7, 2019

 If desire is to fill seat, options in State Law pertaining to vacancy on City Council

Options: 1) Special Election

2) Appointment

# <u>Deadline</u>

Deadline for Council to fill the seat or call for an election:

60 days (from date of vacancy) = August 6, 2019

# Councilmember Vacancy: Options

#### OPTION 1: Take No Action

- Position remains vacant until March 2020 General Municipal Election
- Scenarios:
  - Any tie votes would result in no action taken
  - Any urgency ordinance presented would require an affirmative vote of ALL Councilmembers, rather than 4 out of 5 (occurred 9 times in 3 years)
  - Should 2 Councilmembers be unavailable at a Council meeting, no action can be taken as a quorum would not be established (occurred 2 times in 3 years)

# Councilmember Vacancy: Options (cont.)

## **OPTION 2: Hold a Special Election**

- Call for a special election; must be called no later than August 6, 2019
- Special Election Date: November 5, 2019
- Considerations:
  - Timing -- Anticipated swearing into office date:
     December 3, 2019. Term = 3 months
  - Cost -- \$287,000

# Councilmember Vacancy: Options (cont.)

### **OPTION 3: Appointment**

- Fill vacancy by appointment; no later than August 6, 2019
- Appointment must be made in public
- No legal requirement regarding method of appointment

# Methods to Appoint

Appointment: Two Methods to Consider

- 1. Motion to Appoint
- 2. Application Process

# Motion to Appoint

- Councilmember may make a motion to appoint a specific individual
- Must be seconded and approved by at least three votes

# **Application Process**

- Call for interested persons to submit applications
- May include submittal of nomination paper and statement of qualifications, and oral presentation at a meeting
- Determine: 1) deadline for submittal of applications and 2) meeting date for review of applications
  - Would need to act quickly to meet August 6<sup>th</sup> deadline

# <u>Application Process</u> (cont.)

- Remaining Term: 8 ½ months
- May consider pool of residents with experience, familiarity, and knowledge of Paramount city government – Commissioners
- 5 City Commissions with 5 members on each
  - Pool of 25 residents

# Recommended Action

- Consider the options to fill the vacancy and provide direction to staff
  - Take no action
  - Hold a special election on November 5, 2019
  - Make an appointment by August 6, 2019
