### AWARD OF CONTRACT

- Award of contract for professional services to J.K.
   Designs, Inc. \$103,200
  - Art piece for the Civic Center \$90,000
  - Cleaning of art pieces Citywide \$13,200
- Funding from the Art in Public Places account
  - Collected from buildings permits with a valuation over \$100,000




#### CIVIC CENTER ART PIECE

- Celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 19<sup>th</sup>
   Amendment to the United States Constitution
  - Gave women the right to vote nationwide
- Art piece to also celebrate the historic all-female Paramount City Council
- Art piece to be made from bronze
- Measure 12 feet in height by 4 feet in width

#### CIVIC CENTER ART PIECE

- Art piece to be purchased from J.K.
   Designs, Inc.
  - City has purchased numerous pieces from J.K. Designs, Inc.
  - Clearwater Crossing last piece purchased
  - Cost of \$130,000







#### CLEANING OF ART PIECES

- 2<sup>nd</sup> part of agreement deals with cleaning art pieces Citywide
- Many art pieces are over 30 years old
- Art pieces have not been professionally cleaned and wax conditioned



### SCULPTURE SERVICES OF COLORADO

- Cleaned by Sculpture Services of Colorado
  - Supervised by J.K. Designs, Inc.



- Effects of not cleaning art pieces:
  - Corrosion
  - Calcification
  - Mineral deposits
  - Darkening from carbon monoxide



 Sculpture Services of Colorado has extensive experience cleaning art pieces

#### CITY CONTRACT POLICY

- Contracts in excess of \$40,000 require Council approval
- Contracts to be awarded based on demonstrated competence of contractor – not solely on cost
- The City has purchased from J.K. Designs for decades

 Award contract for Civic Center art piece and cleaning of art pieces Citywide to J.K. Designs, Inc. in the amount of \$103,200

## Recommended Provider



- Interchange rates plus \$0.10 and 0.10% per transaction
- \$0.85 authorization fee per call center transaction
- \$0.25 PIN debit fee per transaction; \$5.00 monthly PIN debit fee
- \$0.10 AMEX fee





# Financial Impact

- Assuming 20-30% participation, annual cost is approximately \$20-30k.
- Convenience fee possibility





#### Recommended Action

 It is recommended that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into contract with Bank of the West to provide merchant services for credit card payments made by members of the public to the City for fees and services.







# Background

- » Since 1997, Paramount has been a grant recipient of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program
- » Department of Justice (DOJ) funds JAG to support crime-fighting efforts through federal funding for local law enforcement agencies
- » DOJ recognizes that JAG offers a cost-effective way to help local law enforcement agencies fight crime





### JAG Guidelines

- » Grant awards vary among cities and are determined by crime statistics and population formulas per city
- » For FY 2020, DOJ awarded \$20,732 in JAG funds to Paramount
- » JAG requires the following actions:
  - Develop a grant project
  - Conduct a public hearing
  - Prepare financial and progress reports



## License Plate Reader (LPR) XL Premium Speed Trailer

» The LPR speed trailer compares captured license plates to law enforcement databases of stolen vehicles, stolen plates, warrant vehicles, and vehicles of interest

- » The LPR speed trailer system alerts deputies when a stolen vehicle, stolen plate, warrant vehicle, or vehicle of interest matches against law enforcement databases
- » The LPR speed trailer also serves as an electronic message board to advise speeding motorists to slow down

#### Procurement



» LPR technology is a proprietary product used by the Sheriff's Advanced Surveillance and Protection Unit



» Vigilant Solutions, LLC holds a purchase certification with LASD, and is the sole provider of LPR technology for LASD



The City's intent to use sole source purchasing complies with PMO Chapter 19, Section 18-29(f): Exemption from bidding upon determination of Purchasing Officer or City Council

### Purchase Proposal

- » If approved by the City Council, staff would purchase the LPR Speed Trailer from Vigilant Solutions, LLC for \$55,465 using the following funding sources:
  - \$20,100 from the JAG funds and approximately
     \$35,500 from the General Fund



» The general budget would be adjusted at mid-year to reflect the added dollar amount
