

# Background

- The City Council approved the service agreement with the Los Angeles County District Attorney.
- Kelly Tatman, Deputy D.A. oversees the Community Prosecutor Program.
- Since 1998, the program provides services to reduce juvenile delinquency, address quality of life issues, combat gang activity, and abate criminal nuisance conditions and activities.



# Discussion

- The Cities of Paramount and Bellflower collaborated to share the cost of a Deputy District Attorney.
- The City of Paramount received notice from Bellflower that they would no longer be participating in the program.
- The City of Paramount approached the City of Lakewood for a new potential partnership and cost share arrangement.

# Discussion Cont'd


- The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors authorized the Los Angeles County District Attorney to enter into an agreement with the cities of Lakewood and Paramount.
- The City of Paramount's share of the agreement for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 is \$192,758.67.
- The shared cost is \$144,569 for the next four consecutive years thereafter, if extended.


# Recommended Action

It is recommended that the City Council approve the revised agreement with the Los Angeles County through the Office of the District Attorney for the Community Prosecutor Program in the amount of \$192,758.47, through June 30, 2023, and authorize the Mayor to sign the agreement.







# Storybook Village

- Saturday November 5, 2022 at Progress Plaza from 10am-12pm








# Storybook Village


