

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


Background

- Each year we allocate funding for streets projects
 - Grinding down the asphalt and repaving
 - Replacing curb and gutter
 - Repairing sidewalks
 - Installing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps
- Streets selected based on Pavement Management Plan
- FY23 project is Orange Avenue from Somerset Boulevard to Rosecrans Avenue



Bid Opening and Results

- Bids opened February 28, 2023
- Six (6) Bids received
 - Bids Ranged from \$779,310 to \$970,150
 - Excel Paving \$779,310
 - Under the budgeted amount of \$800,000



RECOMMENDED ACTION

• It is recommended that the City Council award the contract for the Arterial Street Resurfacing to Palp, Inc., DBA Excel Paving, Corona, CA, in the amount of \$779,310, and authorize the Mayor or her designee to execute the agreement.

BACKGROUND

- Curb address painting:
 - Provides a clear and visible means of identifying property addresses to assist in:
 - Faster emergency response times
 - Delivery of goods and services
 - Others locating properties
 - Provided for all single and multi-family home residences in the City.
 - Commercial properties are not included in this project.



FUNDING

- The City has allocated \$60,000 in the FY 2022-23 Capital Improvement Projects Budget utilizing General Funds
- Previously, this project was funded on a "donation only" basis
- To ensure uniformity and curb appeal for our residents, the City is funding and overseeing this project
- No donation will be solicited by our contractor

BID OPENING AND RESULTS

- Bids opened February 23, 2023
- Three (3) Bids received:
 - Apparent low bid: Project Hope
 - \$50,400
- Bids ranged from \$50,400 to \$75,600





RECOMMENDED ACTION

• It is recommended that the City Council award the contract for the Curb Address Painting to Project Hope, Corona, CA in the amount of \$50,400.





Background

- 15538 Colorado Ave., Paramount, CA 90723
- Former Firehouse Activity Center
- Vacant since 2016
- Currently is uninhabitable due to its deteriorating condition





Surplus Land Act

- On October 9, 2019, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill (AB) 1486
- Agency's use "shall not include commercial or industrial uses or activities, including nongovernmental retail, entertainment, or office development," or "property disposed of for the sole purpose of investment or generation or revenue."
- City notice to all the housing sponsors using California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") database of developers for the purpose of developing:
 - Low- and moderate-income housing;
 - · Open-space purposes; or,
 - Local school facilities or use.
- If no agreement is reached between the City and any interested entity after a good faith negotiation period of 90 days, the land may be disposed of without further regard to the Surplus Land Act.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended that the City Council read by title only and adopt Resolution No. 23:010.
