RE: OPPOSITION TO ASSEMBLY BILL 742: POLICE CANINES, AS AMENDED

Dear Assemblymember Holden:

The City of Paramount writes to express our opposition to Assembly Bill 742 (AB 742), which would limit law enforcement's use and training of police canines.

Paramount is concerned that by limiting the use of police canines, local law enforcement agencies will lose a resource that allows them to de-escalate scenarios of arrest or apprehension. Paramount understands that local law enforcement agencies rely on police canines for their sense of smell to help officers find hidden suspects, which is especially helpful in situations where suspects may respond violently after being discovered. Further, hidden suspects often surrender once warned that canines are being deployed, deescalating the interaction at the onset.

To date a number of law enforcement agencies, including the Riverside County Sheriff's Department and the City of Fresno's Police Department, have voiced concerns in regard to AB 742 and how it would limit their ability to serve and protect communities. Given canines are often used in these high-risk arrest scenarios at the Lakewood Sherrif's Department, Paramount shares these concerns. We feel officers should have access to less lethal resources like police canines in these dangerous situations.
