RE: AB 1 (Connolly) Residential Property Insurance: wildfire risk. Notice of **SUPPORT (As Introduced December 2, 2024)**

Dear Assemblymember Wicks,

On behalf of the City of Paramount, we are pleased to support AB 1 (Connolly), which would require the California Department of Insurance (CDI) to consider updates to its Safer from Wildfires regulations by January 1, 2030, and every five years thereafter. These updates would include consideration of additional property-level building hardening measures and communitywide wildfire mitigation programs.

Wildfires have become a growing threat to California communities due to climate change and decades of fire suppression. Nearly one in four residential structures in the State are in high or very high fire hazard severity zones. As wildfires increase in both frequency and intensity, the State faces not only escalating risks to life and property but also an insurance crisis marked by reduced coverage availability and soaring premiums.

California has taken significant steps to mitigate wildfire risk, investing billions in forest health, defensible space, and home hardening programs. However, insurance industry models often fail to fully recognize or reward these mitigation efforts, leading to nonrenewals, limited coverage options, and higher costs to homeowners – even those who have proactively hardened their homes and participated in local risk-reduction programs.

AB 1 provides a critical step toward addressing this disconnect by requiring the CDI to review and potentially expand its regulations to reflect proven mitigation strategies. including those listed on the State Fire Marshal's Building Materials Listing. These updates will ensure that risk models used by insurers better reflect the actual reduced risk created by local and individual mitigation measures, helping stabilize the insurance market and incentivize continued investment in fire-safe infrastructure.
