NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**Revised Notice of Public Review and Public Hearing to Amend the Annual Allocation Plan
Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26**

The City of Paramount intends to decrease the CDBG budget for the Senior Enrichment Program and reallocate the funding to a new Paramount Shelter Bed Program, as well as reallocate the balance of the FY 2024-2025 CDBG Home Improvement Program funds to the FY 2025-2026 CDBG Home Improvement Program. The City is proposing to adjust the approved budget and amend the approved Annual Allocation Plan for FY 2025-26. To comply with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City has prepared a draft of the amended Annual Action Plan FY 2025-2026. A copy of the draft amendment to the Annual Action Plan FY 2025-2026 has been made available to the public for review and comment for a minimum of thirty (30) day period starting February 12, 2026 to March 16, 2026.

This revised notice follows an initial public hearing notice published on February 10, 2026 for a review period from February 10, 2026 to March 10, 2026. The revised notice and additional review period allow additional public review time in compliance with the thirty (30)-day required minimum.
