**Notice of Public Review and Public Hearing to Amend the Annual Allocation Plan  
Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26**

The City of Paramount intends to decrease the CDBG budget for the Senior Enrichment Program and reallocate the funding to a new Paramount Shelter Bed Program, as well as reallocate the balance of the FY 2024-2025 CDBG Home Improvement Program funds to the FY 2025-2026 CDBG Home Improvement Program. The City is proposing to adjust the approved budget and amend the approved Annual Allocation Plan for FY 2025-26. To comply with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City has prepared a draft of the amended Annual Action Plan FY 2025-2026. A copy of the draft amendment to the Annual Action Plan FY 2025-2026 has been made available to the public for review and comment for a minimum of thirty (30) day period starting February 9, 2026, to March 10, 2026. **REQUEST:** **Notice of Public Review and Public Hearing to Amend the Annual Allocation Plan Fiscal Year 2025-26** to consider a request to decrease the proposed CDBG budget for the Senior Enrichment Program and reallocate funding to a new service, the Paramount Shelter Bed Program, as well as reallocate the balance of the FY 2024-2025 CDBG Home Improvement Program funds to the FY 2025-2026 CDBG Home Improvement Program.

Email public comments must be received 15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting to confirm the emailed comments are received for the item.
